1. Important Safety Instructions

MARNING

Please read all instructions before using this appliance. Failure to follow these safety instructions may result in fire, electric shock, or other injury or damage.

Electrical Safety

- Use only grounded electrical outlets rated for 115V AC, 60Hz
- Do not use extension cords or power strips
- Ensure hands are dry before plugging or unplugging the unit
- Do not operate with damaged power cord or plug
- Unplug when not in use and before cleaning

Water Safety

- · Do not submerge electrical components in water
- · Keep electrical connections away from water
- · Do not operate in wet conditions
- · Ensure proper drainage to prevent flooding

General Safety

- Do not leave children unattended near the appliance
- Do not overload the washing basket
- · Keep fingers and loose clothing away from moving parts
- Do not use for commercial purposes
- Allow unit to cool down between cycles

Features

- Compact portable design perfect for apartments, RVs, and small spaces
- Twin tub design with separate wash and spin compartments
- Multiple wash programs for different fabric types
- Built-in lint filter system
- Easy-drain system with included hose
- Timer controls for wash and spin cycles
- Transparent lid for cycle monitoring
- Non-slip feet for stability

3. What's in the Box

- · Auertech Portable Washing Machine (main unit)
- · Inlet hose with faucet adapter
- Drain hose
- Power cord

Note: Inspect all components upon delivery. Contact customer service immediately if any items are missing or damaged.

4. Installation & Setup

Location Requirements

- Level, stable surface capable of supporting 50+ lbs
- · Access to cold water faucet
- · Access to grounded electrical outlet
- · Adequate drainage area or utility sink
- · Minimum 6 inches clearance on all sides
- · Well-ventilated area

Initial Setup

- Step 1: Remove all packaging materials and protective film
- Step 2: Place unit on level surface and adjust feet if necessary
- Step 3: Install lint filters in both wash and spin compartments
- Step 4: Connect inlet hose to cold water faucet using provided adapter
- Step 5: Position drain hose in sink or drainage area
- Step 6: Plug power cord into grounded electrical outlet
- Step 7: Run a test cycle without clothes to ensure proper operation

Water Connection

Inlet Connection:

- · Attach faucet adapter to your cold water tap
- Connect inlet hose to adapter (hand-tighten only)
- · Ensure all connections are secure but not over-tightened

Drain Connection:

- · Position drain hose in sink or floor drain
- Ensure hose end is lower than washing machine
- · Secure hose to prevent movement during operation

5. Operating Instructions

Before First Use

Step 1: Clean the interior with mild soap and water

Step 2: Rinse thoroughly and dry

Step 3: Run empty wash cycle for 5 minutes to remove any residue

Step 4: Check all connections for leaks

Loading Guidelines

Wash Capacity:

- Maximum 6.6 lbs (3 kg) dry weight
- Do not pack clothes tightly
- · Distribute items evenly
- · Separate colors and fabric types

Spin Capacity:

- · Maximum 4.4 lbs (2 kg) wet weight
- · Wring out excess water before spinning
- · Balance load evenly in spin basket

Washing Process

Step 1: Turn on water supply and check for proper flow

Step 2: Add appropriate amount of detergent to wash tub

Step 3: Load clothes into wash compartment

Step 4: Fill with water to appropriate level (low/medium/high)

Step 5: Close lid and set wash timer (5-15 minutes)

Step 6: Select wash intensity (normal/gentle)

Step 7: Press start button to begin wash cycle

Step 8: Monitor cycle through transparent lid

Spinning Process

Step 1: Remove washed clothes from wash compartment

Step 2: Wring out excess water manually

Step 3: Place clothes in spin basket evenly

Step 4: Close spin compartment lid securely

Step 5: Set spin timer (1-5 minutes depending on fabric)

Step 6: Press spin start button

Step 7: Allow cycle to complete before opening lid

Step 8: Remove clothes and hang to finish drying

Detergent Guidelines

Load Size	Powder Detergent	Liquid Detergent
Small (1-2 lbs)	1 tablespoon	1 tablespoon
Medium (3-4 lbs)	2 tablespoons	1.5 tablespoons
Large (5-6.6 lbs)	3 tablespoons	2 tablespoons

△ CAUTION

Use only low-suds detergent. High-efficiency (HE) detergents are recommended. Do not use bleach or fabric softener in the wash tub.

Daily Maintenance

- · Wipe down exterior with damp cloth
- · Leave lid open after use to air dry
- · Clean lint from filters after each use
- · Ensure drain hose is properly positioned

Weekly Maintenance

- · Clean interior tubs with mild soap solution
- · Check hose connections for wear or leaks
- · Inspect power cord for damage
- · Clean control panel with soft, dry cloth

Monthly Maintenance

- Deep clean with white vinegar solution (1:1 with water)
- · Run empty cleaning cycle for 10 minutes
- · Inspect and clean inlet filter screen
- · Lubricate moving parts if necessary
- Check stability and adjust feet as needed

Filter Maintenance

Lint Filter Cleaning:

Step 1: Remove filter after each wash cycle

Step 2: Rinse under running water

Step 3: Gently scrub with soft brush if needed

Step 4: Allow to air dry completely

Step 5: Reinstall before next use

Inlet Filter Cleaning:

Step 1: Disconnect inlet hose from machine

Step 2: Remove filter screen with needle-nose pliers

Step 3: Rinse under running water

Step 4: Use soft brush to remove debris

Step 5: Reinstall filter and reconnect hose

Storage Instructions

Short-term Storage (1-4 weeks):

· Clean and dry thoroughly

- Leave lids slightly open for ventilation
- Disconnect hoses and drain completely
- Cover with cloth to prevent dust accumulation

Long-term Storage (1+ months):

- Complete thorough cleaning and maintenance
- Remove and clean all filters
- Disconnect all hoses and store separately
- Run empty cycle with vinegar solution before storage
- Store in dry, temperature-controlled environment
- Cover completely with protective material

7. Troubleshooting

Unit won't start

- · Check power connection
- · Ensure lid is closed properly
- · Verify timer is set
- · Check circuit breaker

No water filling

- · Check water supply is on
- Inspect inlet hose connections
- · Clean inlet filter screen
- Verify faucet adapter fit

Water not draining

- · Check drain hose position
- · Clear any kinks in hose
- · Clean lint filter
- · Ensure hose end is lower than unit

Excessive vibration

- · Check if unit is level
- · Ensure load is balanced
- Reduce load size
- Adjust feet for stability

Poor wash results

- · Use appropriate detergent amount
- · Check water temperature
- Don't overload
- Clean lint filters

Water leaking

- Tighten hose connections
- Inspect hoses for damage
- · Check door seals
- Don't exceed water level markings

Unusual noises

- · Check for foreign objects
- Ensure load is balanced
- · Inspect for loose parts
- Lubricate moving components

Spin cycle not working

- · Ensure spin lid is closed
- · Check spin timer setting
- · Remove excess water from clothes
- · Balance load in spin basket

If problems persist after following troubleshooting steps, discontinue use and contact customer service. Do not attempt repairs

- Normal wear and tear items (filters, hoses, gaskets)
- Damage from improper installation or maintenance
- · Acts of nature (floods, lightning, etc.)
- · Commercial or rental use
